Anna-Eva Bergman | Sophie Ristelhueber

For its first participation to Art Paris Art Fair, Jérôme Poggi Gallery is delighted to present the works of Anna-Eva Bergman (born in 1909 in Stockholm, deceased in 1987 in Grasse) and Sophie Ristelhueber (born in 1949 in Paris, lives and works in Paris).

This dialogue between both artists from the 20th and the 21st centuries has been conceived to be part of the section 'A Gaze at Women Artists in France', at Camille Morineau's invitation (Musée de la Monnaie de Paris). Indeed, she is particularly involved in the promotion of female artists through her organization AWARE (Archives of Women Artists, Research and Exhibition), and also officiates as an associate curator for Art Paris Art Fair.

In parallel, Jérôme Poggi Gallery is showing Sophie Ristelhueber's latest series «Sunset Years» until May 4th.

Anna-Eva Bergman (1909/1987, France / Norway)

Born in Norway, Anna-Eva Bergman spent a significant part of her life in France, particularly in Antibes where she lived with her husband, painter Hans Hartung, until she passed away in 1987. Her mixed use of materials such as gold and/or silver leaf combined with painting, as well as her commitment to reveal metaphysical concepts within landscapes places her outside major aesthetic challenges of the 20th century. She was very successful during her lifetime, and her work has been sparking spectacular interest recently. Multiple exhibitions were dedicated to Bergman in the past few years.

Anna-Eva Bergman's work is currently shown in a personal exhibition curated by Vicente Todoli at Bombas Gens Centre d'Art in Valencia (Spain) until May 2019.

Starting in summer 2020, a major retrospective of Bergman's work will be held at the Reina Sofia Museum in Madrid (Spain). The Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris will also dedicate her a retrospective exhibition in 2022, which will then be presented at the Contemporary Museum Oslo (Norway) and at the Museum der Bildende Kunst in Leipzig (Germany).

Sophie Ristelhueber (born in 1949, France)

Sophie Ristelhueber is one of the greatest figures of photography in today's art scene. Since her founding work in the city of Beirut in the early 1980s, she has been committed to pursuing a reflexion on territory and its history through a unique approach to landscape. Like an archaeologist, she questions the marks left by Man or nature on surfaces, making the stigmas of History (recent conflicts, civil wars, earthquakes) visible.

Her work has been shown in multiple international institutions such as the MoMA (New York), the Modern Tate (London), the National Gallery of Canada (Ottawa), the Museum of Fine Arts (Boston). In 2009, the Jeu de Paume Museum has held a major retrospective of her work in Paris.

Sophie Ristelhueber's works are part of major collections, both private and public, such as the Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris and the Musée National d'Art Moderne - Centre Pompidou. In 2009, she was awarded the Deutsche Börse Photography Prize.

GALERIE POGGI

Galerie Poggi is one of the leading galleries from the new French generation. Founded in 2009 by the curator and art historian Jérôme Poggi, its main space is located in front of Centre Pompidou in Paris. For the last 5 years, the gallery has consolidated its international presence through a number of art fairs including FIAC (Paris), Art Basel (Miami), The Armory Show (New-York City), ARCO (Madrid), Zona MACO and Material Art Fair (Mexico City), ARTBO (Bogota), Loop Video Art Fair (Barcelona), Art Brussels (Belgium) and Art Cologne (Germany).

In parallel, Jérôme Poggi founded in 2004 the not-for profit organisation SOCIETIES to experiment new models of political economy for the arts. It encourages and supports private initiatives carried out by any community from the civic society who wants to intervene on the art scene.
